- 1) The Board headed by the Station Officer (I/C), Fire And Rescue Station Kasaragod had inspected the Four (B+G+2) storied Educational Building, height 12.34 metre , in R.Survey Nos 236/2A, in Kalanad village, Kasaragod District under Chemnad Grama Panchayath owned by The President, Jamiya-Sa-Adiya Arabia ,Deli, Kalanad P O, Kasaragod-671317 and recommended to renew the No objection Certificate No. B-2276/2019 dated 22/06/2019 of The Regional Fire Officer, Fire and Rescue Services, Kannur, for the occupation of the said building as per the minutes prepared by the board.
- 2) In the circumstances, this No Objection Certificate is issued under my seal and authority for the continued occupation of the above building. No further construction will be allowed in the vacant spaces provided in the approved plan.
- 3) This certificate is issued on the condition that the firefighting systems installed will be kept always functional and the owner of the building should take special care to maintain the systems installed in proper working condition. This Certificate is valid for one year from the date of issue. After one year, the Certificate must be renewed. Non-renewal of the Certificate within the time limit will result in loss of eligibility for insurance coverage and appropriate legal action by the local self-Government/ Revenue Department. All officers of and above the rank of Station Officers of the Fire and Rescue Services Department will have the right to inspect the building on any day time after serving 7 days' notice to ensure that the installed systems are in good working condition.
- 4) This no objection Certificate pertains only to the firefighting arrangements installed in the building. The civil construction shall be got inspected and approved by the appropriate local authority.
